Overview of AQICC

- Statewide initiative
- Funded by the California HealthCare Foundation
- Partners include California Primary Care Association, clinics, and consortia in California

Purpose of AQICC:

- *Help clinics prepare for MU of EHRs*
- *Improve Clinical Outcomes*
- *Improve Operational Efficiencies*



Current Reporting Information

Data is reported by site

Reporting Period:

July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010

Deadline to provide data to consortia:

August 24, 2010

Note: Clinics who report directly on the CPCA Portal need to submit no later than August 31, 2010



Clinic Incentives

CHCF is providing incentive funding for clinics reporting both clinical and operational measures

Clinical – Must be using an automated registry or EHR to track patients, and at least 50% of patients with diabetes are tracked electronically. Patient counts must be provided from practice management system to determine the % being tracked in registry or EHR.

Operational – Organizations must report on at least one of two core operational measures

Amount Available:

- ***Up to \$3000 for reporting only one set of measures***
- ***Up to \$6000 for reporting both clinical and operational measures***



AQICC Measures

General Information:

- Systems used during reporting period (PMS, EHR, Registry)
- Lab Vendor used and if electronic interface with results
- Are registry reports, prompts, and reminders used

Practice Management Numbers:

- Total number of adults in the PMS or EHR
- Total number of adults with diabetes in the PMS or EHR



AQICC Clinical Measures

- Total number of adults with diabetes in Chronic Disease Registry
- Number of patients with HbA1c screening and Glycemic Control (<7, >=7 and <=9, >9)
- Number of patients with LDL-Cholesterol screening and Cholesterol Control (<100, >=100 and <=130, >130)

AQIC Reports are available for these measures in your Registry system (i2iTracks, PECS, CVDEMS, CDEMS). Updates have been made for this reporting period so make sure your system has the latest version. Contact your consortia for more information about this.



AQICC Operational Measures

Reporting Period for Operational Measures
May 1, 2010 – August 31, 2010

Clinics required to report on at least one of the following measures by site

- Cycle Time
- Third Next Available Appointment
